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# What is self-paced learning?

- In Colin's dictionary, self-paced is an educational system,
- course done or designed to be accomplished at the students' speed.

# What do researchers say about it?

Naidu (2008) defines self-paced learning as “a mode of learning that enables individuals to study online or with the help of portable technologies in their own time, at their own pace, and from their own place” (p. 260).

# SO

**Self-paced learning** refers to a learning method where individuals control the speed and timing of their education. This flexibility can enhance comprehension, retention, and motivation
