

- As a student who is not interested in publishing, you do not have to create this profile to use Google Scholar. You are, however, welcome to fill in the personal information if you'd like.



The labels feature allows you to create specific tabs that are similar to folders where you can organize articles based on topic, read status, and more.





The process of creating a label is much like creating a new folder on Google Drive. Let me show you **how to create one!**





Create separate labels for each project or paper you write


- When you create the name of a label be sure to include the name of the course the assignment came from.


