# What is a Pivot Table?

- ▶ A **Pivot Table** is a powerful tool to calculate, summarize, and analyze data that lets you see comparisons, patterns, and trends in your data.
- ▶ A **Pivot Table** is a table of statistics that summarizes the data of a more extensive table.
- ▶ **Pivot Tables** are one of Excel's most powerful features. A **pivot table** allows you to extract the significance from a large, detailed data set.
- ▶ **Pivot Tables** are a reporting engine built into Excel. They are the single best tool in Excel for analyzing data WITHOUT FORMULAS.

# What is a Pivot?

- ▶ A **Pivot** is a thing around which other things rotate.
- ▶ An axis is an imaginary line around which things rotate.

- ▶ Mostly from other applications, e.g. Google form.

# Data form



- ▶ The data must be in a **Tabular Format**

One row of headers that describes the data.

- ▶ **Requirements:**

- ▶ No blank columns.
- ▶ No blank rows.
- ▶ No merged cells
